

The church will provide a bus for the parade. If you're planning on taking the bus, please reserve your seats with Mr. Triantafillou (Greek School) or Mrs. Anastasia (Community) in the church office. The bus will leave from the front of the Church at 12:00 noon sharp, immediately following church services. There is no charge for students, teachers, and GOYAns. All others will pay \$20.00 each plus you'll be asked to give a \$1 tip for the bus driver.

Please reserve the bus in advance or we cannot guarantee your seat. This will also help us determine how many buses we will need.

Parade Guidelines:

- · Ethnic Costumes or Business Attire ONLY, preferably in Blue and White the colors of our Flag
- T-shirts or shirts with advertising or "Odd ball" dress is not permitted. NO JEANS, LEGGINGS OR CUT-OFF TOPS. (You may be asked to march in the back with community marchers)
- GREEK SCHOOL STUDENTS & GOYA DRESS CODE (as above and including)
 Ethnic costumes are best. Or white shirts for boys, white tops for girls, with navy blue or black bottoms (slacks, knee length skirt, or sports uniform, no leggings). Black shoes (weather permitting)
- No eating, drinking or smoking in the Line of March.
- No animals or mascots.
- After the unit gets onto 5th Avenue, no stragglers will be allowed to join the unit. Families with strollers may march with the community after the last group of Ascension Organizations.
- Leaders of organizations shall not delay the parade by leaving their places for any purpose and should line up their group evenly as they prepare to march.
- ALL BANNERS, SASHES AND FLAGS SHOULD BE CHECKED WITH THE PARADE COMMITTEE IN ADVANCE.

And remember, you are on Fifth Avenue for one hour once a year so march with pride in our culture & heritage. PLEASE DRESS AND ACT ACCORDINGLY.

CONGRATULATIONS GRADUATES CLASS OF 2023


On May 21, 2023, our community will honor the youth of our Ascension family for graduating from an accredited college/graduate/law/ medical schools in 2023.















