

Archepiscopal Encyclical on Greek Independence Day

March 25, 2024

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of the Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and entirety of the Christloving Plenitude of the Sacred Archdiocese of America:

Onward, children of Greece ... now is the fight for everything! (The Persians, Aeschylus)

Beloved sisters and brothers in Christ,

The battle cry of the ancient Greeks as they charged the forces of Xerxes at Salamis, more than four hundred years before the gentle reply of the Virgin to the Archangel, is an inspiring testament to the resilience and courage of our People, our Genos. Although they were severely outnumbered, they never gave up their hope for their freedom and fought their way to victory. The same is true of the Immortal Heroes of 1821, whose memory we invoke on the Great Feast of the Annunciation, which is the most perfect story of humanity's aspiration for true and compete liberty.

Although tender was the answer to the mighty Gabriel, "Be it unto me according to you word," the response of the Virgin actually carries the same force and intensity of the Greeks who repelled the Persians, as well as their descendants who freed Greece from over four hundred years of Ottoman occupation. For truly, the salvation of the human race – initialized and empowered by the assent of the Theotokos to the Incarnation of God – is and has always been "the fight for everything."



Human liberty – the ability to live our lives in a climate of opportunity and with freedom of choice – is always a struggle. The miracle of the Annunciation is that through a young girl, chosen by God, our ultimate freedom has been guaranteed in Christ. Whether repelling invaders, or expelling occupiers, the Greek People have always risen to the challenge. And with the faith of the Gospel, we behold our decisions to "fight for everything" under the aspect of eternity, sub specie aeternitatis. For the contest of the human spirit is not only against the oppressors of this world, but also, as the Apostle says: "against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" (Ephesians 6:12).

Therefore, beloved brethren in the Lord, let us magnify the Virgin Theotokos, who embodies with her mildness a strength worthy of her title as our "Champion Leader" ($\Upsilon\pi\epsilon\rho\mu\alpha\chi\sigma\varsigma$ $\Sigma\tau\rho\alpha\tau\eta\gamma\dot{\sigma}\varsigma$). And let us give thanks to God for the courage of our ancestors – both those of the ancient world and those of 1821 – who gave of their lives in the fight for everything. Because of their sacrifices, we possess as a precious treasure the glory of Greece and the glory of our Holy Greek Orthodox Faith.

Long live Greece!

«Ὁ παῖδες Ἑλλήνων ἴτε ... νῦν ὑπὲρ πάντων ἀγών» (Αἰσχύλος, Πέρσαι 402-405).

Προσφιλεῖς ἀδελφοὶ καὶ ἀδελφὲς ἐν Χριστῷ,

Ή πολεμική ἰαχή τῶν ἀρχαίων ἐλλήνων στὴ ναυμαχία τῆς Σαλαμῖνος ἐναντίον τῶν πλοίων τοῦ Ξέρξη, τετρακόσια χρόνια πρὶν ἀπὸ τὴν καταφατική ἀπάντηση τῆς Παρθένου Μαρίας στὸν ἀρχάγγελο, εἶναι ἀκόμη μία ἐμπνευσμένη ἀπόδειξη τοῦ θάρρους καὶ τῆς ἀνθεκτικότητος τοῦ γένους μας. Ἄν καὶ οἱ Πέρσες ὑπερεῖχαν σὲ ἀριθμὸ καὶ δύναμη, οἱ Ἑλληνες δὲν ἐγκατέλειψαν ποτὲ τὴν ἐλπίδα τους γιὰ τὴν ἐλευθερία, πολεμώντας γιὰ τὴν τελικὴ νίκη. Ἁκριβῶς τὸ ίδιο ἰσχύει καὶ γιὰ τοὺς ἀθάνατους ἥρωες τοῦ 1821, τοὺς ὁποίους μνημονεύουμε σήμερα κατὰ τὴν μεγάλη ἑορτὴ τοῦ Εὐαγγελισμοῦ τῆς Θεοτόκου, τοῦ γεγονότος ποὺ ὁδήγησε ὅλη τὴν ἀνθρωπότητα στὴν ἀληθινὴ καὶ πλήρη ὲλευθερία!

Άλήθεια, πόσο τουφερή καὶ ταπεινή ήταν ή ἀπάντηση τῆς ἀειπαρθένου Μαρίας στὸν πανίσχυρο ἀρχάγγελο Γαβριήλ: «ἰδοὺ ή δούλη Κυρίου· γένοιτό μοι κατὰ τὸ ὑῆμά σου»! Όμως ή ἀπάντησή της, ή ὁποία ἐλευθερώνει τὸ ἀνθρώπινο γένος ἀπὸ τὴν άμαρτία, ἔχει τὴν ἴδια δυναμική μὲ τὴν ἰαχὴ τῶν Ἑλλήνων, ποὺ ἀπώθησαν τοὺς Πέρσες, ἀλλὰ καὶ τῶν ἀπογόνων τους ποὺ ἀπελευθέρωσαν τὴν Ἑλλάδα μετὰ ἀπὸ τετρακόσια χρόνια ὀθωμανικῆς κατοχῆς. Διότι πράγματι, ή σωτηρία τοῦ ἀνθρωπίνου γένους, ξεκίνησε μὲ τὴ συγκατάθεση τῆς Θεοτόκου στὴν ἐνανθρώπηση τοῦ Θεοῦ, καὶ αὐτό, ἐν τέλει, ἀποτελεῖ τὸν «ὑπὲρ πάντων ἀγώνα».



Ή ἐλευθερία τοῦ ἀνθρώπου, ἡ δυνατότητα νὰ ζοῦμε μὲ ἐλεύθερο φρόνημα, ἀποτελεῖ πάντα ἔναν ἀγώνα. Τὸ θαῦμα τοῦ Εὐαγγελισμοῦ εἶναι ὅτι μέσφ μίας νεαρῆς κοπέλας, ἐπιλεγμένης ἀπὸ τὸ Θεό, γίνεται ἡ ἐνανθρώπησή του, κατοχυρώνοντας ἔτσι τὴν ἀπόλυτη ἐλευθερία μας ἐν Χριστῷ. Ἔτσι ὁ Ἑλληνικὸς λαός, εἴτε ἀποκρούει εἰσβολεῖς, εἴτε διώχνει κατακτητές, ἀνέκαθεν ἀνταποκρίθηκε στὴν πρόσκληση γιὰ τὴν ἐλευθερία. Μὲ τὴν πίστη τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου, ἡ ἀπόφαση γιὰ τὸν «ὑπὲρ πάντων ἀγώνα», ἀποκτάει τὴν προοπτικὴ τῆς αἰωνιότητος (sub specie aeternitatis). Γιατὶ ὁ ἀγώνας μας δὲν εἶναι μόνο ἐνάντια στοὺς καταδυναστεύοντας αὐτὸν τὸν κόσμο, ἀλλὰ ἐπίσης, ὅπως λέει ὁ ἀπόστολος Παῦλος: «πρὸς τὰς ἀρχάς, πρὸς τὰς ἑξουσίας, πρὸς τοὺς κοσμοκράτορας τοῦ σκότους τοῦ αἰώνος τοῦτου, πρὸς τὰ πνευματικὰ τῆς πονηρίας ἐν τοῖς ἐπουρανίοις» (Έφεσίους 6:12).

Γιὰ τὸ λόγο αὐτό, ἀγαπητοί μου ἐν Κυρίω ἀδελφοί, ἄς μεγαλύνουμε τὴν Παναγία Θεοτόκο, ή ὁποία με τὴν πραότητά της δείχνει μία τρομακτικὴ δύναμη ἀντάξια τοῦ τίτλου της ὡς «ὑπερμάχος στρατηγοῦ». Ἄς εὐχαριστήσουμε ἐπίσης τὸ Θεὸ γιὰ τὸν ἡρωϊσμὸ τῶν προγόνων μας, τόσο τοῦ ἀρχαίου κόσμου ὅσο καὶ τοῦ 1821, ποὺ ἔδωσαν τὴ ζωή τους γιὰ «τὸν ὑπὲρ πάντων ἀγώνα». Λόγω τῆς πολύτιμης θυσίας τους κληρονομήσαμε τὸν ἀνεκτίμητο θησαυρὸ τῆς δόξης τῆς Ἑλλάδος καὶ τῆς ὀρθοδόξου πίστεως.

Dear parishioners, members of all church organizations and Greek School,

Our community will participate in the Greek Independence Day Parade on Sunday, April 14 @ 1:00 PM in New York City. We will also have a float with participation of all organizations and Greek School.

The church will provide a bus for the parade. If you are planning on taking the bus please reserve and pay for your seat(s) by calling or visiting the church office, tel. # 201-945-6448, by Friday, 4/12. Otherwise, we cannot guarantee you a seat. This will also help us determine if we need a second bus.

The bus will leave from the front of the Church at 12:00 noon sharp, immediately following church services. Teachers, students and Goyans are free. All others will be charged \$25.00.

Dress code: Business attire preferably blue and white, our flag colors.

Greek School students and GOYA dress code

Ethnic costumes are recommended. Or, white shirts for boys, white tops for girls, with navy blue or black bottoms (slacks, knee length skirt, or sports uniform.) Black shoes (weather permitting). Please follow dress code directions from Mr. Triantafillou for Greek School students and GOYA advisors for GOYA.

- T-shirts, shirts with advertising are not permitted. No jeans, leggings or cut-off tops.
- Leaders of organizations shall not delay the parade by leaving their places for any purpose and should line up their groups evenly as they prepare to march.
- Once our unit gets on 5th Avenue, no stragglers will be allowed to join. Families with strollers
 may march with the community after the last group of Ascension Organizations.
- All Organizations should check their banners, sashes and flags ahead of time.

It is our obligation as a parish to march in the parade with our community. We expect all organizations to be present in marking our 72^{nd} year. Together we stand strong. We should march with pride of our culture & heritage.




