

The Parish Council and all the Ascension Organizations continue their mission to help sustain our Parish that is important to our families and children.

The Board has implemented several upgrades to our community that are of great importance. Recently we installed 28 cameras and a motion alarm system surrounding both our school and parish. Presently, new ceiling tiles with LED lights have been installed in our church vestibule. Painting will commence shortly for this vestibule and both hallways leading to the exit stairways.

In addition, the board and general assembly approved the parking lot construction on Henry Street. A contractor was awarded, and we are waiting for the permit to begin construction immediately. We are hoping to get this completed by Easter. Further, we have another number of projects brewing and should begin within the 3rd quarter of this year.

A number of maintenance issues arose from leaky roofs, new school boiler, cleaning, updating equipment for inspections that were costly. All these items take up considerable time, effort, devotion, and dedication. The church relies on donations to help complete these crucial and necessary projects. It is our duty to help our Parish continue to preach our faith, heritage, and customs. Together we can accomplish all of our goals.

We thank everyone for their love and support of our membership/stewardship fund. It would be of great help to donate any additional funds to help subsidize these projects.

Please take the time to ascertain that your paid membership is up to date. If you have not yet paid, either mail a check to the Ascension Church or call the office to pay via credit card.

We have achieved so much in the past and for that we are very proud. It is our duty to try and secure the future of our Church and our children. It is difficult to act alone but very easy when we work together. Jesus taught us "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them".

Membership dues/stewardship begin at a minimum of \$450; seniors begin at \$350.
