

Ποὸς τοὺς Σεβασμωτάτους καὶ Θεοφιλεστάτους ἄρχιερεῖς, τοὺς Εὐλαβεστάτους Τερεῖς καὶ Διακόνους, τὶς Πρεσβυτέρες καὶ τὶς Διακόνισσες, τοὺς Μοναχοὺς καὶ τὶς Μοναχές, τοὺς Προέδρους καὶ τὰ Μέλη τῶν Κοινοτικῶν Συμβουλίων, τοὺς Ἐντιμολογιωτάτους ἄρχοντες τοῦ Οἰκουμενικοῦ Πατριαρχείου, τὰ μέλη τῆς Ἡγεσίας τῶν 100, τὰ Ἡμερήσια καὶ ἄπογευματινὰ Σχολεῖα, τὶς Φιλοπτώχους Αδελφότητες, τὴ Νεολαία, τὶς Ἑλληνορθόδοξες Όργανώσεις καὶ ὁλόκληρο τὸ Χριστεπώνυμο πλήρωμα τῆς Τερᾶς ἄρχιεπισκοπῆς Αμερικῆς.

«Καὶ οὐκ ἔστιν εἶς ἀντεχόμενος μετ' ἐμοῦ περὶ τούτων, ἀλλ' ἢ Μιχαὴλ ὁ ἄρχων ὑμῶν.» (Δανιήλ 10:21).

Προσφιλείς άδελφοι και άδελφες εν Χριστώ,

Στὸ ὄφαμα τοῦ προφήτου Δανιήλ, ὁ ἀρχάγγελος Μιχαὴλ ἀποκαλύπτεται ὡς ἰσχυρὸς παράγων ὑπὲρ τοῦ ἀγαθοῦ καὶ ὑπερασπιστὴς ἐναντίον παντὸς κακοῦ. Ανατρέχοντας τὴν Άγία Γραφὴ διαβάζουμε ὅτι οἱ ἄγγελοι ἑμφανίζονται σὲ ποικίλα μέρη καὶ σὲ ἀριθμούς, ποὺ πολλὲς φορὲς ξεπερνοῦν τὴ φαντασία μας. Όμως ὀφείλουμε πάντοτε νὰ ἔχουμε κατὰ νοῦ ὅτι «ἄγγελος» σημαίνει «ἀγγελιοφόρος», κάποιος δηλαδὴ ποὺ μᾶς φέρνει ἕνα σπουδαῖο μήνυμα ἀπὸ τὴ Βασιλεία τῶν Οὐρανῶν.

Κάθε ἔτος έορτάζουμε τὴ Σύναξη τῶν παμμεγίστων Ταξιαρχῶν μὲ τὰ ἐννέα τάγματά τους, στὰ ὁποῖα ἐπικεφαλεῖς εἶναι οἱ ἀρχιστράτηγοι Μιχαὴλ καὶ Γαβριήλ. Σὲ μιὰ τέτοια ἡμέρα, ἄς ἀφιερώσουμε λίγο ἀπὸ τὸ χρόνο μας γιὰ νὰ θυμηθοῦμε τὰ

σπουδαῖα ἔφγα ποὺ ἐπιτελοῦνται στὸν οἶκο εὐγηφίας «Ἅγιος Μιχαήλ», τὸ ἴδφυμα τῆς Ἅφχιεπισκοπῆς μας γιὰ τὴ φφοντίδα τῶν ἠλικιωμένων. Ὁ ἀφχάγγελος Μιχαὴλ θεωφεῖται ὁ κφαταιὸς πφοστάτης καὶ φύλακας ἐκείνων ποὺ διαμένουν στὸ ἴδφυμά μας αὐτὸ καὶ συμπαφίσταται σὲ αὐτοὺς τόσο σὲ αὐτὴ ὅσο καὶ στὴν ἄλλη ζωή.

Αὐτὴ τὴ χονιά, ὰς σκεφτοῦμε ὅλοι νὰ κάνουμε μία δωρεά, ὁποιουδήποτε ὕψους, πρὸς τὸν οἶκο εὐγηρίας «Άγιος Μιχαήλ», προκειμένου νὰ στηρίξουμε τὶς γενεὲς ποὺ προηγήθηκαν πρὶν ἀπὸ ἐμᾶς. Ἡ Άγία Γραφὴ ἀναφέρει τὸ περιστατικό, ὅπου ὁ ἀρχάγγελος Μιχαὴλ στάθηκε ὡς ὁ μοναδικὸς ὑπερασπιστής. Όμως τὸ μήνυμα εἶναι ξεκάθαρο, διότι ὅλοι μας μποροῦμε νὰ πάρουμε θέση ὑπεράσπισης μαζὶ μὲ τὸν ἄγιο ἀρχάγγελο, καὶ νὰ γίνουμε ἔνα ἀδιαπέραστο τεῖχος προστασίας, στήριξης καὶ προσευχῆς γιὰ τοὺς ἡλικιωμένους μας. Μὲ αὐτὸ τὸν τρόπο, θὰ συμβάλουμε γιὰ τὴν κατασκευὴ τῶν νέων δομῶν ποὺ θὰ στεγάσουν καὶ θὰ προστεύσουν τοὺς ἡλικωμένους μας στὸ καινούργιο κτίριο τοῦ «Άγίου Μιχαήλ».

Archepiscopal Encyclical for the Feast of the Archangels Feast of the Synaxis of the Holy Archangels

November 10, 2024

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Holy Archdiocese of America:

And there was no one who stood with me against them, except Michael, your prince.

(Daniel 10:21)

Beloved brothers and sisters in Christ,

In the visions of the Prophet Daniel, Archangel Michael is revealed as a powerful force for good and protection against every possible evil. If you look through the Holy Scriptures, you will read of Angels appearing in all manner of places — sometimes in numbers that even defy the imagination. But we should always bear in mind that "Angel" means "messenger," someone who is delivering to us an important communication from the Heavenly Realm.

Every year, on November 8, we celebrate the Synaxis of the Holy Angels — all Nine Ranks of them, who are led by their Chief Commanders, Michael and Gabriel. At the same time, we take time to remember Saint Michael's Home, our Archdiocesan Institution that cares for the elderly. Archangel Michael is considered the residents' special protector and guardian, who stands with them in this life and the next.

This year, let us all consider a donation — of any size — to Saint Michael's Home in order to support the generation that came before us. Holy Scripture speaks of a moment when Archangel Michael was the only one to take a stand and make a defense. But the message is clear, all of us can take our place with the Holy Archangel to become an impenetrable wall of support and prayer for our aged. And in doing so, we will contribute to the construction of the new walls that will house and protect our elderly at the new Saint Michael's Home.


COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS OPPORTUNITY



Fr. Barnabas (Charles) Powell is a native of Atlanta, Georgia. Having been raised in a small Pentecostal church as a boy, Barnabas grew to love the church, enjoy the music, and eventually came to be the youth pastor of his home church. In 2007 Barnabas was given the blessing of Metropolitan ALEXIOS of Atlanta to enter Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology in Brookline, MA.

On November 8th 2009, Barnabas was ordained to the diaconate in his hometown of Atlanta, GA at Annunciation Greek Orthodox Cathedral by His Eminence Metropolitan Alexios and on Sunday March 8, 2010 he received ordination to the holy priesthood at the same cathedral.

He is now the proistamenos (senior pastor) of Sts. Raphael, Nicholas, and Irene Greek Orthodox Church in Cumming, GA. Fr. Barnabas founded Faith Encouraged Ministries in 2014 and was the host of Faith Encouraged LIVE talk show on Ancient Faith Radio until January 2019. Fr. Barnabas is married to the (former) Connie Demas, and they have two daughters, Alexandra and Katherine.
